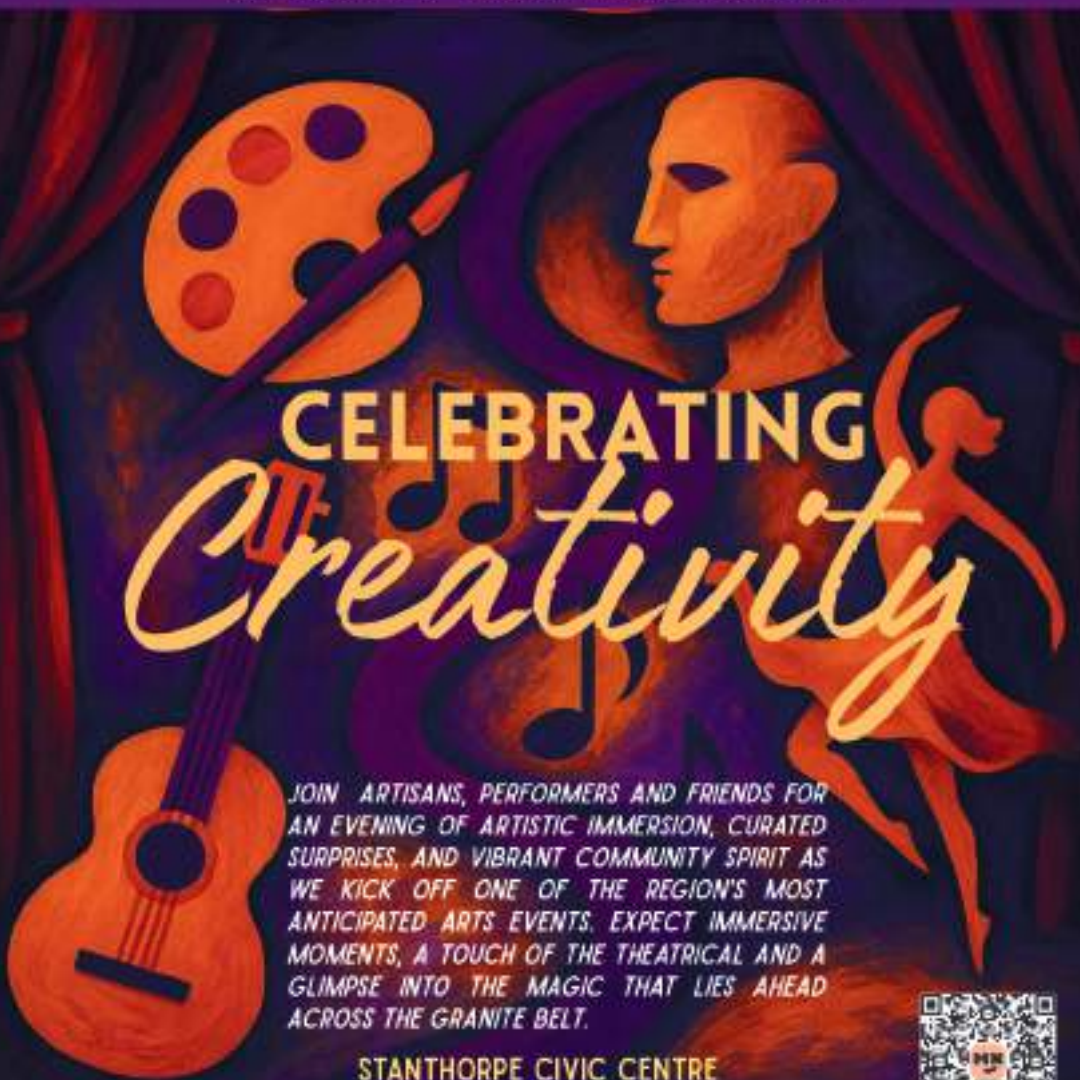

#### INDIGO AND SILK WORKSHOP

During this workshop we will play with indigo and silk using shibori techniques i.e. clamping and stitching to resist indigo dye, to make scarf lengths of dyed silk. By lunchtime you will have created your own line of individual silk scarves. Shibori techniques include stitching folds in different directions, giving patterns once the silk is dyed. Clamping and folding the silk between different shapes extends this technique and is a quicker option. It's an addictive method, watching the indigo dyed fabric morph into a rich blue, as you undo the stitching and clamps is always exciting.

**Based in Tenterfield**, Liz Powell is a mixed media artist with a career spanning decades. A 1978 graduate of the National Art School, she has exhibited and taught extensively across Australia and internationally. Her teaching roles include Fibre Arts NZ, Grampians Textures, and major regional galleries. She has exhibited with the Papermakers of Victoria and Queensland, the International Association of Papermakers and Artists. She is President of Borderline Regional Arts, a founding member of the Artist's Collective Studio Gallery, and her work is held in several public collections including State Library NSW.

Since 2000 she has won over 20 awards, including the Inaugural Hawkesbury Art Award. Her work is represented in many private and govt collections and galleries in Australia and overseas.

Naomi is a visual master painter, distilling the essence of the land and the moment, in the mind's eye. With a background in textile design, she often relays the beauty, pattern and colour that she sees in the environment.

In the last 25 years Naomi's focus has been in acrylics and collage. Having developed a technique of using layers of colored tissue paper under and over the painted surface. This gives the surface a three dimensional textural quality. She is often literally painting with paper.

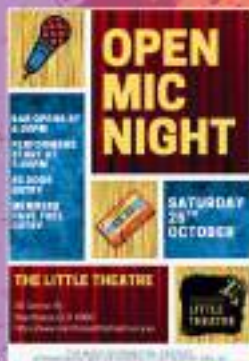

Tal'ngal Alpacas is a working farm and fibre art studio nestled in the Granite Belt, home to a herd of up to 30 alpacas. Over 20 years, the artist has developed a deep connection with fibre, using her own alpaca fleece in every stage—from shearing, washing, and carding to spinning, knitting, weaving, and felting. She creates garments, doonas, floor mats, and needle-felted portraits. Visitors can explore the studio, view a traditional Mongolian GER with hand-felted walls, meet the alpacas, and purchase unique fibre products. As this is a working farm, pets must remain in vehicles during visits.



The process of both wet and needle felting will be demonstrated. This will highlight the difference between these two methods. In both cases, mainly alpaca fibre will be used. Other natural fibres such as silk, merino, yak, stinging nettle or mohair may be used to embellish the piece being created.

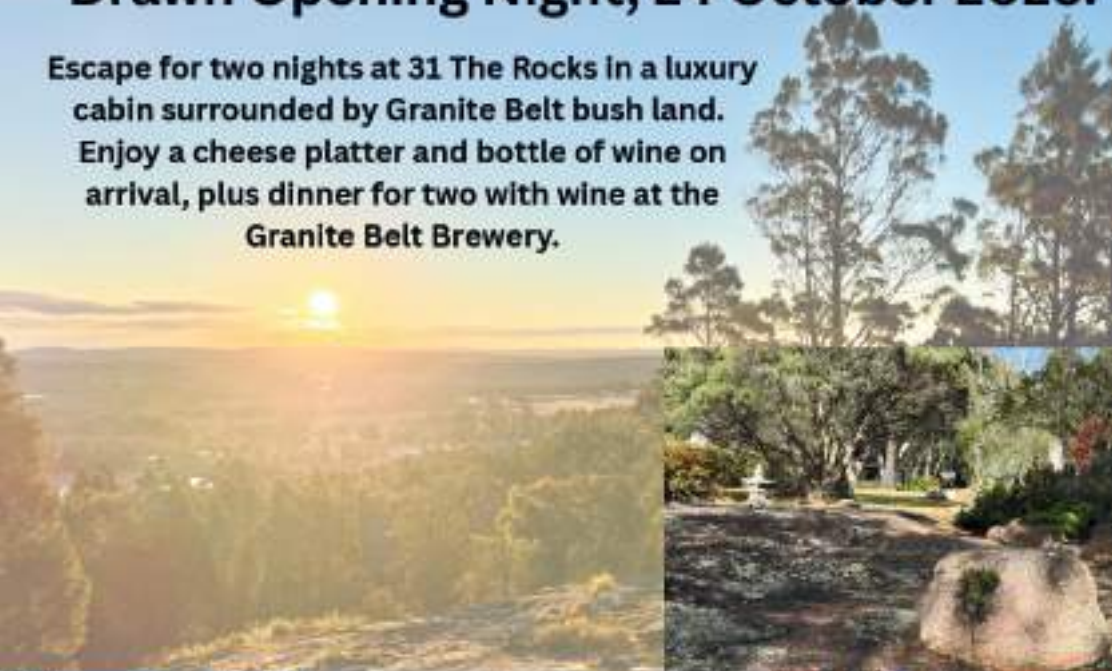

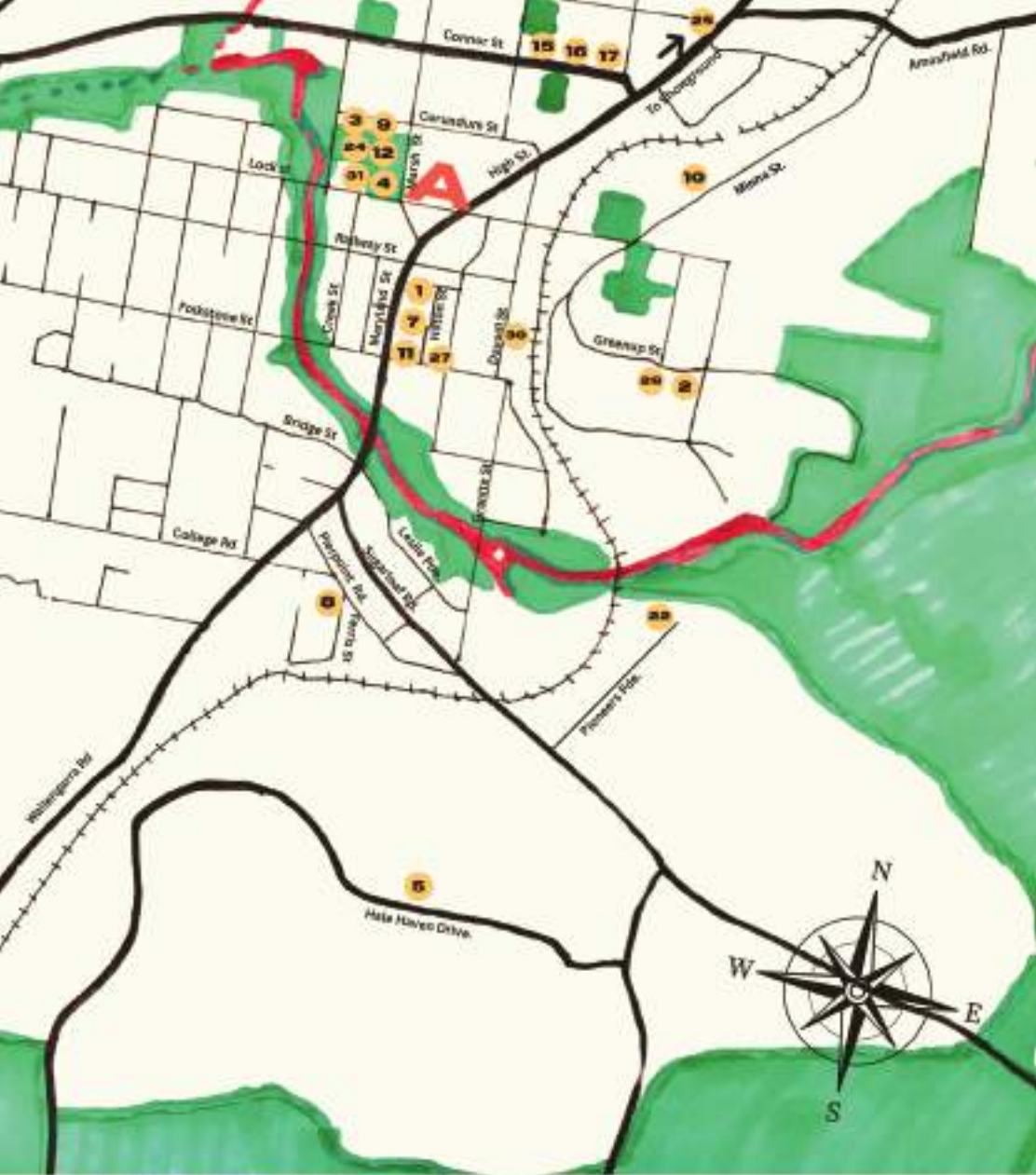

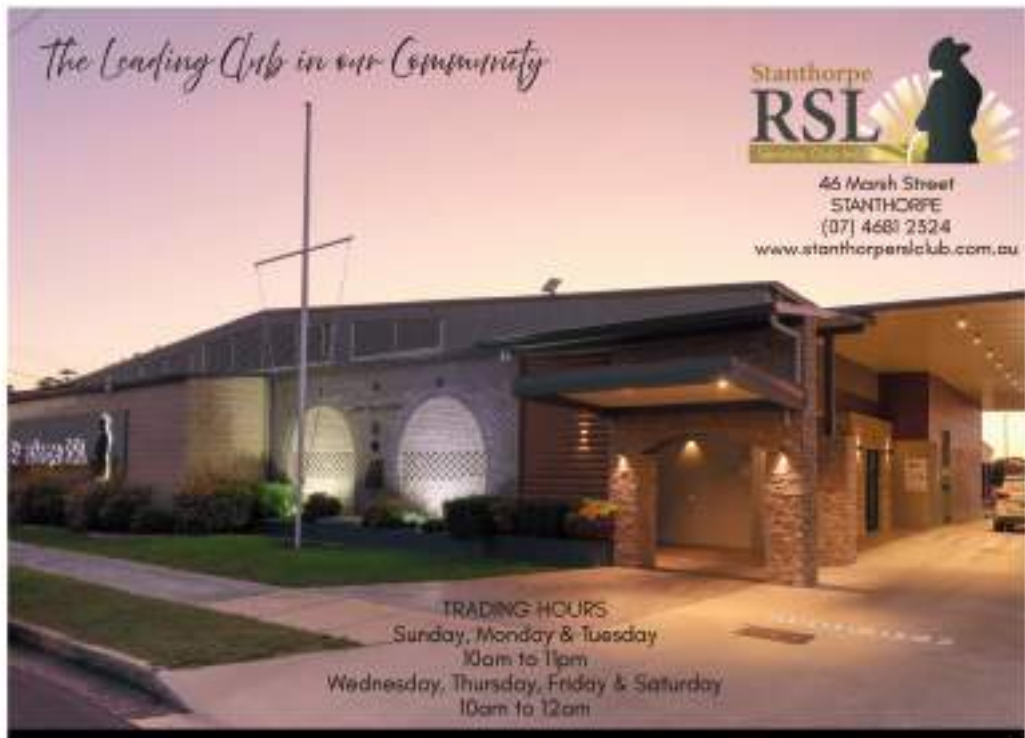
