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Stanthorpe's Big Thermometer

The Big Thermometer has been a popular tourist attraction since its installation and launch in November 2017. Beautifully positioned in Rotary Park alongside the scenic Quartpot Creek, it is a drawcard for visitors, locals and the media whenever the temperature starts to drop during the cooler months.

A Chamber member, Mick Spiller has been the driving force for the Big Thermometer project and was instrumental in rallying local supports and volunteers to make this idea become a reality. It was funded by contributions from Southern Downs Regional Council, Qld Gambling Grants, Better Regions Federal grant, in-kind donations from tradesman and fundraising efforts from Chamber and the Stanthorpe Rotary Club. A significant community-led project.

You can have an opportunity to become a permanent part of this tourist attraction, by ordering a commemorative plaque that will be installed in the pathway leading to the Big Thermometer.

The plaques will depict the names of businesses and / or families that wish to be immortalised as part of the landscaping around this iconic structure.
